

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION FOR COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP

Eligibility

The Championship is open to all members of the Association who hold a current CONGU Handicap of 20 or less. Players with the 64 lowest handicaps will be accepted

Entry

The entry form in the Fixtures Handbook must be completed and returned to the Competition Secretary accompanied by a cheque made payable to CCLGA. Late entries may be accepted by the Competition Secretary up until the time she makes the draw for the Qualifying Round.

Format

This is a scratch competition.

There will be a 36 hole Qualifying Round. The players returning the 16 lowest scores will qualify to play in the match play competition. (At check-in on the qualifying day, players must declare whether or not they are available to play on all 3 days). They should also declare, on first registering, if they qualify for the Millenium Trophy (i.e. 18 - 24 on 1st January 2015).

In the event of a tie for the final qualifying place (s), it (they) shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3, 1. Then a hole-by-hole play-off shall be used. In the event of a tie continuing, the place shall be decided by lot.

The draw for the match play will be by automatic draw.

The players knocked out in the first round of the match play will go on to play in the Sir William Bailey Cup.

Times of Starting and Groups

The County Captain and Competition Secretary shall draw the pairings and times of starting for the qualifying competition.

The Captain and Competition Secretary shall determine the starting times for the match play, both for the Championship and the Sir William Bailey Cup.

Failure to start on time is covered by Rule 6-3.

However, Rule 33-1 allows the Committee to modify the penalty of disqualification.

Allowance is also available to alter printed starting times to afternoon rounds in the event of a player having to play extra holes in the morning round. These modifications will be used.

Players are to report to the Starter 5 minutes before their tee-off time.

Check-In

All players must check in at the Competition Secretary's desk prior to teeing off.

They must show their current Handicap Certificate to prove their eligibility to take part in the competition.

Players must declare whether or not they are available to play on all 3 days. Can they also give their availability for County Match Week (Monday 22nd June – Friday 26th June 2015).

Prizes

A player may take more than one prize.

Balls

Players must use balls from the List of R & A Conforming Golf Balls.

Caddies

Professional golfers may not act as caddies

Decisions

The Committee reserves the right to alter times etc.

The decision of the Championship Committee will, in all matters, be final.

Prizes

Champion: Trophy, Brooch and Prize (Lady Captain)

Runner Up: Trophy and Prize (Lady Captain)

Semi Finalists: Voucher each

Leading Qualifier: Trophy plus Prize (Lady President)

Sir William Bailey Cup (Winner of the 8 defeated players in the 1st round of match play): Trophy plus voucher

Sir William Bailey Runner Up: Voucher

Millenium Winner (Age 18 – 24) (Best 18 hole score am or pm on qualifying day): Trophy plus voucher

Intermediate Championship (Best 36 score in main Championship): Voucher

Handicap Prize: Best 36 hole score net in qualifying rounds: Voucher
